Traditional MBA Format

Our Traditional MBA format offers classes on campus during the evenings from 7pm - 9:45pm, Monday – Thursday; there are no Friday or weekend classes. The Fall and Winter semesters are 15 weeks long and courses meet one night per week. The Spring and Summer semesters are 7 weeks long and each course meets two nights per week. The MBA Traditional format does not have cohort groups; students can create a schedule to meet his/her individual needs. Students may take one, two or three courses per semester or take semesters off, if needed. We work with our students to develop an MBA plan to fit the student's needs. We also offer courses in our flexible NetPlus! format, online and daytime courses.

The Traditional MBA format offers a great diversity through the educational and employment backgrounds of our students. With the diversity offered in the MBA program, students are encouraged to develop personal and professional networks that will last for many years to come. Students are encouraged to network with professors and other MBA professionals during their time in the MBA program. Deep connections are built during the semester long interactions.
